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PISA 2018 U.S. Results

•Compared to the 35 other OECD members, the US average in reading literacy was lower than the average in 4 education systems, higher than in 21, and not measurably different than in 10 •On a scale of 0 to 1,000, average scores in reading literacy across the education systems ranged from 555 in B-S-J-Z (China) to 340 in the Philippines

Financial literacy is defined as "people's ability to process economic information and make informed decisions about financial planning, wealth accumulation, debt, and pensions" (Lusardi and Mitchell, 2014) Being financially literate is important for
